John 1:1-9	In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.
Psalms 27:1	The Lord is my light and my Salvation
Psalms 119:105	Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.
Proverbs 6:23	For the Commandment is a lamp; and the Law is Light.
John 3:19-21	This portion of Scripture, spoken by Jesus, shows clearly that sin is symbolic of darkness, and truth is symbolic of light.
John 12:46	I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness.
1 John 1:5	God is Light, and in Him is no darkness at all.
